Here is some general information regarding camp that may help you:

**THE PARTICULARS:** Troop 45 will once again be camping at the Theodore Roosevelt Council's Onteora Scout Reservation in Livingston Manor, NY. As this is our Council's Home Camp, most of the Troops in camp will be from Nassau County. We will leave for camp the morning of **Sunday, July 9th** and return the afternoon of **Saturday, July 15th**.

**CAN WE CALL OUR SON AT CAMP?** The simple answer – **NO**. Due to the size of the camp and the number of Scouts attending each week, it is virtually impossible to get a phone call to a Scout. Should you have an emergency, you can call the camp and they will find your son. The camp office's phone number is (845)439-5239.
